3 The first goat to cross the bridge was the \_\_\_\_\_ Billy Goat Gruff. (Clue: opposite of biggest, little in size)


4 'Leave me,' said the smallest goat, 'my brother will make a much better \_\_\_\_\_\_ than me.' (Clue: what is eaten, dinner)
